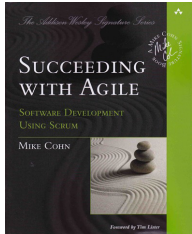

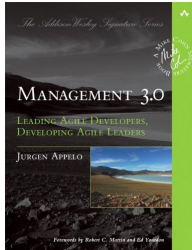
### Mike Cohn

#### Certified Scrum Product Owner 1 - 2 February, 13 - 14 June

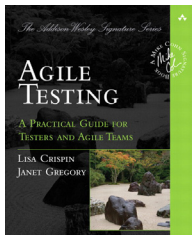

#### Management 3.0: Agile Leadership Practices 13 - 14 March

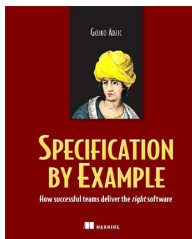
